PRESIDENT'S REPORT 1962

Gentlemen,

Another year has passed, a year full of incidents, a year in which referees in general were subjected to a spate of criticism to a greater degree than ever before. In the main the criticism was unjustified and because of the source can be ignored.

The standard of refereeing was good but, nevertheless we must not become complacent but should constantly strive to increase our efficiency.

In the midst of the criticism we were greatly heartened by the support given us by the President of the New South Wales Rugby League Mr Bill Buckley.

During the off season the N.S.W. Rugby Football League has devoted much time and energy to ways and means to advance our code, and this year will see some changes in the rules which should prove beneficial to the game and to the spectators.

One aspect of the game which still requires attention, and the remedy is in the hands of referees, is the elimination of the deliberate. This infringement is bottling up our game and spoiling it as a spectacle. People will pay to see constructive football and we have our part to play to see that they get it. Offenders must be dealt with and shown that this negative action will incur a penalty far outweighing any temporary advantage to their team.

ALTERATIONS TO THE LAWS OF THE GAME

The following alterations to the Laws of the Game and recommendations covering other aspects of the game were approved of by the General Committee of the New South Wales Rugby Football League at a meeting held on 12th. November 1962 :-

- (a) That the League adopt the suggestion of the International Board in respect to the scrummage rule viz: That the ball must come out from behind the second row of players.
- (b) That the hooker strike for the ball with the foot furthest from the point of entry.
- (c) That the League agree with the suggestion of the International Board that the Play the Ball Rule could be improved if the value of the Penalty Kick was increased and it is agreed that this be done by allowing the advantages of putting the ball in the scrum and the loose head to the non-offending side where a penalty was kicked into touch.
- (d) PLAY THE BALL - That the League agree with the International Board that Referees should be instructed that all offending players should be penalised in an all-out effort to clean up the Play the Ball Rule.
- (e) SCRUM - That all grounds be marked with a ten yard intermittent line and referees be instructed that scrums must be formed in-field from that line.

JUDICIARY COMMITTEE-REPRESENTATION. That a player or referee be not allowed representation when appearing before this Committee.

Deliberate Breaches of Rules That the Judiciary Committee for 1963 be instructed to treat more seriously players sent off the field for deliberate breaches of the rules.
