



CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Thank you for the honour of representing the New South Wales Rugby League Referees Association as Chairman for this my third consecutive year.

In last year's Annual Report I forecast that there were challenging times ahead. This year did not disappoint. Armed with the knowledge that a National Structure for officials in Rugby League was a real possibility the Board of the Association set about securing a place in any future structure for the NSWRLRA. The Board did not wait for an invitation to be involved in this process we went about seeking an opportunity and secured an audience with the stakeholders in NSWRL and the NRL. This was not just about having our brand on an organisation structure it is about what we can deliver and produce for the benefit of the game into the future. The Board presented a proposal for the NSWRLRA to drive and control District development in the NSW aligned District competitions. This proposal was supported by both the NSWRL and NRL. Our new responsibilities have led to the creation of four new NSWRLRA Coaching positions. These positions belong to the Association and will drive and assist Coaching and Development in the Districts. The positions are designed to assist the people who are currently coaching in the Districts. They will provide support and resources to make their job easier and help retain and produce our next generation of quality referees.

Whist the National Structure is yet to be confirmed the NSWRLRA has proactively found a place in any structure that will be considered in this State or nationally. This is something we need to invest in to ensure its success so we can continue to see the NSWRLRA hold a place in the game that has responsibility and is respected. Our social and welfare activities which is of great value to any organisation or Association will continue well into the future if we maintain this core responsibility and place we have found in the game.

The Referees Association also successfully argued for a position on the selection panels for both the Junior Representative and NSWRL Referees' Coaches. The Association is again in a position to observe the process of selecting the right people to coach our Active Members. The Board also supports the development of our members as Coaches whilst still active. This will help the game retain quality people to Coach and mentor our referees into the future. There has been much discussion about a career path for referee's coaches. This is certainly an opportunity the Association should be exploring alongside the decision makers in our game. We would like to see our organisation involved in the development of our people following their on-field career. Our coaches should be just like Active referees, developed and mentored so they can rise through the ranks as a Coach. As we reach out to our Districts we may find other opportunities to develop quality people into Coaches. There may also be room for our membership to discuss Grading coaches similar to how we Grade referees. Not every good Rugby League Coach was a great player and we can probably say the same about referees. Coaching is a different discipline and we should open our minds to expanding our membership to these people.

The NSWRLRA increased Coaching and Development grants to the Districts this year with the top tier receiving \$5,000. This

shows a genuine commitment by the Association to assist the Districts. Next year we will see the next phase of assistance with our people on the ground supporting the people who keep recruiting and developing our Referees in local Associations.

In last year's Annual Report I stated our intention to focus on the Affiliates and Junior Development of Referees. These plans were disrupted with Doug Keen's role at the NSWRL being made redundant. With this change of circumstance, Matt Hewitt as the Director of Coaching and Development and Affiliate Liaison assisted with the Sydney Combined Competition evaluations and appointments. The NSWRLRA funded these evaluations in an effort to take the load off the Districts concerned. Whilst this was never going to be the perfect solution it was done in the spirit of co-operation and I thank Matt and all the evaluators for the work they put into this competition.

The Association negotiated with the NSWRL to secure funds to compliment the NSW Squad fees. This was achieved through the sponsorship of Bryden's Lawyers. The League provided \$25,000 which the Squad voted to put into Sydney Shield fees. We thank the League and Bryden's Lawyers for this outcome.

Our Active Referees were also supplied with moulded earpieces. This is a great tool to assist our referees in this age of electronic communication on field. My mind goes back to the days when this technology was first introduced. Carrying what felt like a back pack and having a speaker on your ear which at times required more strapping than a 20cm wound to your forehead just to keep it on your ear. Thankfully our referees today won't have to worry about those distractions during their games thanks to this equipment supplied by the Association.

The Life and Senior Members Luncheon was a great day. The coming together of our membership to celebrate the history of the game and Rugby League Referees was something special. I believe this is something critical to the Association's growth. I hope all our members that attended the day at the SCG had a great day and with the support of the membership I am sure another significant day can be arranged again next year.

Thank you to the management of the NSWRL and NRL who have supported the Association's activities and initiatives all year. It is so important that our Association continues its current working relationship with the Leagues. Whilst we may not agree on everything the greater good of the game and the Association is always at the centre of debate. To our coaches and evaluators led by Tony Archer and Tony Danks in both the NRL and NSWRL competitions thank you for investing your time into our Active members.

PAUL SIMPKINS

Thank you to all of the 2016 Board members. Unfortunately Brendan Wood was unable to complete all functions of his portfolio due to increasing work commitments which took him to International destinations. This meant that all other Board members had to pitch in and organise the social functions. Whilst this added a significant workload to each Board member it was a symbol of what these people will do to benefit the Association. Matt Hewitt and Frank Leonard led the way in this area. Thank you Darren Gocher who has been able to establish some clear systems behind our finances to enable the Board to make informed decisions on Budget items and know the exact status of our financial membership. The introduction of Memberships for Life, extended payments and active members rolling over their authority for fee deductions has created a more efficient administrative system for the future.

Thank you to both Faye Lehane and Tim Robinson for their help during the season. Tim filled in admirably in the area of Member Services assisting in organising social events and BBQ's. Tim has a passion for this role and has been encouraged to continue to service the Association in this area. Faye acted as the Executive Officer when Frank went overseas for a month. This is a difficult position to fill but Faye took it on with enthusiasm and was of great assistance to the Board. On behalf of the Board I thank both Tim and Faye for their help and encourage them to continue to take an active role in the function of the Association.



On field our members again excelled. The NSWRL and NRL Grand Finals were great days and the officials added to the quality of the football. To all officials who participated in representative and finals football,congratulations on your achievement.

The NSWRLRA stands ready to assist each League, our membership and our Districts to help referees develop and achieve their maximum potential in the game.

As this year comes to a close I am excited about how the Association is positioned to move forward. After some time of uncertainty we now have an endorsed role in the games development. We have some robust financial systems in place. There is increased interest in social activity as we witnessed at the SGC lunch. We have built relationships with the NRL and NSWRL who have endorsed our position in the game and made our Association stronger.

With much of the back of house business attended to this year we acknowledge we still have plenty to do. We need to look at the structure of our General Meetings and how they are conducted so we can engage our Active membership in Association business and decisions. We need to increase our engagement with the NSW and NRL squads. With a secure future comes increased confidence and performance. I am sure our members and the Association are now in a position to enjoy both.

EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

It is with much pleasure that I present the 109th Annual Report on the activities and achievements of the New South Wales Rugby League Referees" Association for the year 2016.

In 2015 a decision was taken by the Board and endorsed by the membership to reduce the size of the Board to five requiring two of the Directors to manage two Portfolios. Unfortunately work commitments prevented one of the newly elected Directors from the ability to commit himself fully to either Directorship, especially Members Services which had then to be shared by three Directors including the Chairman. In early October the incumbent resigned creating a Casual Vacancy which the Board filled with Tim Robinson. This was a timely replacement as there was the Life Members Luncheon, Brooklyn Bash, the Annual Presentation Evening, the Annual Les Matthews Golf Day and Convivial following the Annual General Meeting to be organised and conducted.

In June the NSWRL declared the position of Doug Keen, a member of the Referees' Coaching and Development Unit, redundant. Since this change was immediate it took the Board, especially recently elected Directors, some time to pick up, address and continue to implement some of the areas of responsibility which Doug held as a member of the Association. Both the NRL and the NSWRL provided assistance in this area and we express our gratitude to Brad Levy and Kasey Badger of the NRL and Tony Danks, Yvette Downey and BJ Mather of the NSWRL for offering their support and seeking to build closer working relationships with the Association, building on what Doug had contributed and extending into other areas where it was recognised we should be working together.

The major change that was deemed to be hanging over the Association's head was the development of a National Structure for refereeing. Rumours and Chinese whispers abounded about the changes that would or could be made. In this climate of speculation the Chairman insisted that the Board act to ensure that the NSWRLRA would continue to have a position of strength in the game's structure and that Coaching and Development of referees was where the Association could make the greatest contribution especially at Affiliated Associations' level. Meetings were held with personnel from the NRL, the NSWRL and representatives from Affiliated Associations. A decision was made to seek permission from the NSWRL to engage four Coaching Advisors who will work with Coaches from the Affiliates and be paid an honorarium for their services. In early October the NSWRL appointed Gavin Badger to oversee this development which suggests that the scheme devised by Paul Simpkins and Matt Hewitt will be funded in 2017 and of great benefit to the Affiliated Associations.

OTHER 2016 INITIATIVES

- Steve Clapson and Sean Hampstead procured some funding from the Association to purchase a Ref's Cam for Referee Specific Videos which allows the Coaches to film the performance of a referee, solely. Players are excluded largely from the footage. For some referees this has been game changing for they can see what MDA's and Coaches have been telling them that is something that is real rather than fantasy and needs to be worked on rather than dismissing the advice as coming from a "dinosaur".
- Steve Clapson has also developed a Referee profiling tool which is still in its developmental stage
- Joint Coaching Sessions were held at Bangor for St George, Canterbury and Cronulla Associations, at Penrith for Penrith and Parramatta Referees and at North Sydney for North Sydney, South Sydney and Manly referees. Organised largely by Shayne Hayne with a high representation of NRL referees, working with District Coaches these were deemed very successful attracting an average of seventy referees to each Session. What has to be determined for 2017 is the best way to follow up on these Clinics.

- Pro Zone was introduced into the Ron Massey Cup and the Sydney Shield, a facility that provides for more accurate observation of game incidents and greater accuracy of information for debrief and judiciary purposes. Clips from Videos are used as a teaching tool at the Monthly debriefs of the Graded Squad.
- NSWRLRA received a \$25,000 sponsorship from Brydens the Lawyers for a two year period and consulted with the Grade Squad as to how they would like the funds spent. The decision was to increase the Fee for Sydney Shield games and to purchase ear pieces for the Squad.
- Darren Gocher has overhauled the manner in which Financial Records are developed, stored and reported upon, making use of an Accountancy Firm, BASIC for monthly assistance with Tax Systems and Accounting
- To ensure Affiliated Associations are always financial, \$20 to be withheld from their Administration Grant each year.
- To ease the burden of keeping track of Financial Non-Active members a two tier fee structure was introduced providing an option for I) \$50 for a five year membership (ii) \$150 to become a member for Life. For Pensioners, \$10 for a five year membership OR \$30 to become a Member for Life.
- G-Mail introduced allowing for faster communication with the total membership.
- Changed the format and venue of the Life Members Luncheon to be all inclusive that proved very successful. The Annual Presentation Evening was also changed in response to members' wishes in terms of venue, format and conduct.

REFEREE MOVEMENT

Prior to and during the early part of the season Martin Jones, Jake Sutherland, Cameron Paddy, Patrick Mackey, Darren Burtenshaw, Danny Constantine, Tim Hannon, Cameron Mitchell, Keith Povah and Ryan Walters were added to the Graded Squad. Early in the year Ryan Walters resigned and returned to the Newcastle – Coalfields Association while during the year Taylor Deland-Cleveland resigned from the Squad and joined the Illawarra Association. Promoted into the Emerging Talent Squad at NRL Level were Liam Nicholls and Drew Oultram. Lawrence McDonell resigned for personal reasons.

CONGRATULATIONS

To the members of the NRL Squad who gained representative and Finals Series appointments. Notable amongst them were Ben Cummins, Matt Cecchin, Gerard Sutton, Alan Shortall, Gavin Badger, Grant Atkins, Jeff Younis, Brett Suttor, Jason Walsh, Russell Turner and Nick Beashel. Several games were standouts and included State of Origin 1 and 2, The Broncos v the Cowboys Final and the Grand Final won by the Cronulla Sharks over the Melbourne Storm, their first in fifty years in the competition.

Congratulations must also go to Jon Stone who was appointed from his position in the NRL Squad under a Memorandum of Understanding between the NRL and the NSWRL signed at the beginning of the season, to referee his second NSW Cup Final and run a pocket referee in the Inter-State Championship played between the Illawarra Cutters who narrowly won the NSW Cup but very convincingly defeated the Burleigh Bears, winners of the Queensland State Cup. Congratulations are extended to all members of the NSWRLRA appointed to Representative and Major Competition fixtures a full summary of which can be found on Pages 34-36 and 42-44, inclusive, in this Annual Report.

The Association congratulates the Cronulla Sharks on winning the NRL Telstra Premiership in a gripping Grand Final that was anyone's game until the final whistle. Congratulations also to the Illawarra Cutters on a very close win over The Mounties in the NSW Cup, 21-20 to The Mounties on their win in the Ron Massey Cup and to East Campbelltown on a second Sydney Shield Premiership defeating the favourites, the Mounties. In all three games our referee teams performed to expectations and some will be anxiously awaiting announcements re promotions to one of the NRL Squads in 2017.

To all Referees from our fifteen Affiliated Associations who were selected for the Junior Representative Squad, appointed to District Finals, Grand Finals and other significant fixtures throughout the year the Association extends its sincere congratulations and trusts that you will return to contribute further to this great game in 2017. At the same time we recognise and thank all those referees officiating in their first or second years as well as "the Tradesmen" from each Association without whom the Associations would not be able to meet their weekly appointment commitments nor function as an organisation.

THANK YOU

I am not going to reiterate a thank you to all the Rugby League bodies I thanked in the 2015 Report for they continue to provide the funding and the support that allows us to contribute to the game. The Board is especially grateful, however, to the management of the NSWRL for the additional \$25,000 funding that arose from a sponsorship by Bryden the Lawyers, and allowing the Graded Squad to determine how this sponsorship should be spent. The Board will continue to work closely with the NSWRL during 2017 as we deal with and implement the changes that will accompany the National Structure, the changes made to Mini and Mod League and to the Safeplay Code.

I wish to also thank my fellow Directors who have worked with me under a new Board structure. It hasn't been an easy



year because of the work commitments of Directors other than myself, all four occupying high profile positions in their respective careers. Nonetheless, we believe we had our eye on the ball for most of the year and had things in place as they fell due. Most importantly we believe we have a place in the new structure and will contribute significantly to the development of referees, particularly at grass roots level, in partnership with the NRL and the NSWRL,

Once again my role has involved much travel and time away from home and I am very grateful for the support I received from my wife, Marie, in the role. Whilst it could be time for a generational change where a much younger member might see themselves ready to succeed me as the Executive Officer I would prefer to see someone take up a minor Directorship and 'learn the ropes' over a twelve month period. The Annual General Meeting to be held on the 12th December will determine what happens.

To all who take the time to read this Report I extend best wishes to you for the Christmas Season and look forward to being with you all again in 2017.

ROBERT CULKIN

Graded Number 382

Robert Culkin reunited himself with the Association some four years ago and was quickly befriended by Doug Keen and Greg McCallum. After several attendances at meeting s where the Chairman extended him a welcome, Robert would respond with "It's nice to be here. In fact, at my age it is nice to be anywhere." So quickly did he make an impression on the Board of Directors at the time that he was made the Association's first Ambassador and presented with a blazer and pocket that indicated his position. He wore it from that point on with great pride.

Born during the First World War, Culkin moved to Sydney in 1944 from Wellington, in country NSW. He trialled with South Sydney but was persuaded by friends to take up refereeing instead.

It's been 72 years since he first blew a whistle, but his impact on the game was not lost.

Still in possession of his original referee's ticket, Culkin was the oldest living grade referee, the oldest living member of the NSWRLRA and the oldest living member of the Men of League. CEO of the NRL Todd Greenberg described Culkin as a "true Rugby

League treasure" and recalled meeting him at the 70th anniversary of the All Schools Tournament in Penrith in 2014; 68 years after he refereed at the inaugural event.

Having seen the game evolve over the decades, Culkin said he would have done just fine in the modern era without the assistance of technology.

When asked who the best official was during his time as a referee, Mr Culkin cheekily replied: "I'd have to back myself."

Robert celebrated his 100th birthday on the 12th July and presented the jerseys to the Match Officials involved in the State of Origin III fixture at ANZ Stadium. This event was covered by Channel 9 and both Gerard Sutton and Todd Greenberg spoke very highly of Robert and the need we have to remember those who "dug the well"

Robert passed away on the 3rd September leaving a wife and family, many friends and fond memories for many of us within the Association.

We are poorer for his passing.







MAX TOMSETT Graded Number 584

Dubbed "The Prince of Touch Judges", Max Tomsett passed away on the 20th May, 2016 after a long battle with Cancer.

Max joined the Balmain District Referees' Association in 1956 and was in his 64th year as a member of the Association when he passed away. After five years as the Number one referee in the District, Max was Graded into the NSWRL where he progressed as far as Reserve Grade in the centre prior to becoming a Touch Judge. In this role, Max officiated in 308 First grade games and gained numerous appointments to International and interstate matches, including the inaugural State of Origin Match at Lang Park in 1980.

MICHAEL O'NEILL Graded Number 733

DIRECTOR OF FINANCE REPORT **DARREN GOCHER**

I have pleasure in presenting the Financial Statements of the NSWRL Referees Association for the year ended 31 October 2016 for your adoption.

The financial position of the Association is healthy. As at year end, we had \$157,020 of cash in the bank. We have been able to invest in Coaching and Development and assistance for our Graded Squad and Affiliate Associations throughout the season. There are a number of important strategic and development initiatives planned for the coming season, so we intend to utilise these funds to continue to improve on the quality of our referees and the structures required to facilitate that. This year was about consolidating our position and setting the foundations and improving processes. Next year, the Board wants to invest in critical areas to shore up the future of refereeing and assist in driving recruitment and retention. Next year's financials will reflect that.

The Association finished the year with a surplus of \$35,400, up from \$10,018 the prior year. However, this included a one-time credit of \$11,413 from an unreconciled balance from previous years. Without this one-time credit, the surplus would have been \$23,987. This is in line with the budget prepared and presented to the NSWRL at the start of the season.

The Board continued to focus funds and investment on the areas we believe will promote and improve refereeing. While the social aspect of the Association is critical, the Board has been

very careful in how we fund the various social functions to ensure we can continue to invest in refereeing. Social expenses were down \$15,000 year on year. This season, the major difference in our expense line has been the decrease in Masseur fees of approximately \$48,000, due the NSWRL taking responsibility for this account. Our grant from the NSWRL was reduced to \$167,000 (down from \$205,000 previously) to reflect this.

We also introduced a new Non-Active member fee structure this year, with a "member for life" fee of \$150 or 5 years at \$50, making administration considerably easier on collection of fees.

It has been a year of transition for the finance function. Building on the excellent foundations created by previous Finance Directors, the goal has been to establish the processes and systems that provide the strong governance that the Board, members and governing bodies expect. At the same time, we have tried to simplify the function significantly and ensure we are in line with best practice organisations of a similar size and nature.

There have been significant changes made to streamline the way we are operating. This year, we have moved to being

completely paperless. Our accounting system is "in the cloud" and all on-line, with invoices scanned and attached digitally to every transaction. We have done away with a cheque book and all approvals are also done on-line or over e-mail. Our Bank Account feeds into it, making the reconciliations easy and the governance and approval process bar set at a high level. This is the way that we should be operating this function into the future.

Being back involved with the Association this year and joining the Board has been an honour. I had some hesitation initially on what would be involved, but understanding how the Board is trying to position the Association and the professionalism shown in how they have gone about it, is commendable. I am happy to be involved in the transformation.

I would personally like to thank Paul Simpkins, Frank Leonard and Matt Hewitt for their support, dedication, hard work and vision for where the Association needs to go. They have absolutely driven the agenda tirelessly, with nothing else in mind other than the best interests of the Association. Brenden Wood, Faye Lehane and, more recently, Tim Robinson's contribution to delivering on this vision should also be commended. It has been a pleasure to work with all of them.

As we continue to secure our place in the Rugby League structure, there couldn't be a better group of people positioned to deliver it. We also need to continue to find members with the same passion and vision to ensure succession planning into the future.

Our relationship with the NSWRL I felt was also strengthened throughout the season. I'd like to offer a big thank you in particular to both David Nissen (CFO) and David Trodden (CEO), for their overwhelming support of both myself and the Association as a whole throughout the year. They have proactively given their time to support the Association and aligned with the vision on how we continue to grow.

I'd also like to thank our Internal Auditors, Peter Filmer and outstanding job in getting the audit done with an incredibly tight timeline. Also to Jimmy Oliveira for assisting with the handover.

A final thank you to all of our members, who have made it a pleasure to be back involved with the Association.

DIRECTOR OF REFEREE DEVELOPMENT & AFFILIATE LIAISON REPORT MATTHEW HEWITT

In the second year as a Director of the Association, my attention was drawn to the future role that the Association will have in Rugby League.

In order to remain relevant, it is important that we devote our energy and finances to the development of referees. We advised our affiliates at the Annual Conference that Grants for Coaching and Development would be increased for 2016. These Grants were made available at the beginning of the season so that our Affiliates could use the funds in 2016. The grants are still tied to criteria and we will review our Affiliates performance before the end of 2016. The performance of the Affiliates in meeting the Grant criteria will be reflected in their funding for 2017.

A number of our Affiliates organised Combined Training Sessions this season. I have to congratulate Jared Maxwell's initiative for organising the first session. It was hosted by Cronulla

and involved Canterbury and St George. There were a number of NRL First Grade Referees in attendance as well as Tony Archer. This was followed up with combined sessions involving Penrith and Parramatta, Manly and North Sydney and Balmain and Souths. We look forward to these combined sessions continuing and expanding next season.

The Sydney Combined Competition has been operating for a number of seasons. The appointment of Officials for this competition was previously managed by the NSWRL Referees Unit. Following Doug Keen's departure from the NSWRL we were asked to assume responsibility for the appointment of referees for this competition. We sought applications and appointed Match Day Assessors for this competition. On behalf of the Association I would like thank George Jankowski, Col White, Barry Ruttle, Doug Keen, Dave Allen and Wayne Loveday for their efforts in evaluating referee's performances. When a number of Districts are involved there will be robust discussion about performance. We tried to see as many referees as possible officiating in the Senior Grades of this competition. Each Evaluator was asked to rank the referees so that Final Series appointments could be made. It is the Board's view that we will no longer have a role in appointing Officials for this competition. These games are controlled by local District Officials and the appointments should be managed by the District where the match is played.

In line with our commitment to spend more funds in development, we continued with the "Ref Cam" program. In consultation with Steve Clapson and Sean Hampstead referees from our Junior Representative Squad were filmed to assist with their positioning. This program has been very valuable to these referee's development. It has also allowed Steve and Sean to engage with our Affiliates about the coaching of their District Officials. We look forward to continuing with this program next season. Steve and Sean's coaching continued to bear fruit for the game with a number of referees from the Junior Representative Squad being selected for the Graded Squad mid-season.

2016 brought in changes to the appointment of officials for the NSW Intrust Super Premiership. Officials from the NRL were appointed to referee these fixtures. Whilst this may have caused disappointment to the Active members of our Graded Squad it is healthy for refereeing that there is strong competition for positions. The standard of Rugby League played in this competition has improved considerably. As a result the preparation of referees for First Grade is better served in this competition rather than the NYC.

On behalf of the Association I want to thank Tony Danks, Peter Filmer, Mick Lewis, Paul Kalina and Phil Cooley for their efforts this season. It is a long season and a great deal of commitment is required by the Coaches to ensure that our Active referees are performing well. We have a number of Referees with the potential to referee higher grades. We look forward too many of our Active members achieving higher honours in the future. To those members who achieved Grand Finals in NSW congratulations. It is a reward for your performances throughout the season. To those officials not involved, continue to try and be the best that you can. Dedication to your craft does bring rewards.

Throughout 2016 we were involved in meetings with the NRL and NSWRL about a National Refereeing Structure. As an Association, we support this program. We must have an active involvement in this structure to ensure that we are promoting our referees and continue to have a meaningful long term role in the game. As mentioned in last year's Annual Report we are competing with the QRL and CRL to supply referees to the NRL. We have to ensure that we are giving our referees every opportunity to progress through the Grades. It is essential that coaching is consistent across the game, particularly for those referees from our Affiliates identified as having potential.

We understand the ARL Commission will make a decision on the National Structure before the end of this year. We expect that the Commission will endorse the Structure. In anticipation of this major change we have advertised for coaches to work with our Affiliates. Their brief will be to ensure that the coaching methodologies of the National Structure are being delivered. They will also have input into ensuring that the criteria for our Coaching and Development Grants is being delivered. With the likely introduction of the National Structure it is an opportunity for NSWRLRA and our Affiliates to improve what we do. It is important that we put resources into our Coaches to give our referees the best possible start that we can. Change can be difficult to accept but we need to embrace it.

This season, with the reduction of Directors on the Board, I also had the responsibility of Affiliate Liaison. With the amount of impending change in Coaching and Development I did not give as much attention to this portion of my portfolio as I would have liked. As mentioned above I was able to attend the Combined Training Sessions and was involved in an issue that one of our Affiliates had to deal with. I was also involved in co-ordinating the Life Member's Luncheon and the Annual Presentation Dinner. This involvement at times diverted my attention from my core Board responsibilities. It is important as an Association that we support our Affiliates and they feel that they can approach us for assistance.

Although the 2016 season has concluded we have much to do in preparation for 2017. Whilst the workload has increased due the changes that are occurring I have relished my involvement. It has been difficult at times juggling the demands of my business and my role with the Association. I hope that I have made a meaningful contribution to the development of referees in NSW and look forward to 2017.

NRL ELITE PERFORMANCE MANAGER'S REPORT

Season 2016 in the National Rugby League signalled a number of firsts, both on and off the field with the introduction of the shot clock around scrums and drop outs, a reduced interchange and the introduction of the bunker to our game in the decision making process.

People in Rugby League will always debate any change and specifically in relation to match officiating as it is always topical. But at the end of the season the conclusion was what the bunker provided to the game was a faster, more accurate, more consistent and the most transparent review process.

Another first was achieved this season with a landmark agreement between the Head of Football at NRL, NSWRL and QRL with the implementation of a Memorandum of Understanding in relation to second tier competitions officiating. This effectively identified the two second tiers as one and saw officials appointed to matches in all three competitions in one season regardless of their origin. It is a significant and importantly first step to ensure that a true National approach to refereeing occurs in this country.

NRL Referees proudly spent a greater amount of time supporting the grass roots officiating. I would like to thank our Pathway Coach, Shayne Hayne who with Jared Maxwell and Alan Shortall designed and delivered with the help of the rest of the full time squad, Combined District Training sessions. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Chairman thanked the members of the Board for their

assistance throughout the year. He particularly thanked Doug Keen and Luke Bugden, long-serving Directors who had served the members well in the areas of Affiliate Liaison and Social Events as well as in general matters. Because of the Board restructure and advice from the NSWRL in the case of Doug Keen relating to possible conflicts of interest, they would not be standing for re-election for 2016. Both had indicated their interest in serving on Committees.

The Chairman referred to the introduction of a Centre of Excellence by the NSWRL stating it was a big step compared to where we were not long ago.
